Mayor Hall called the special meeting of the Eden City Council to order.

Closed Session to discuss personnel pursuant to NCGS 143-318.11(a)(6).

A motion was made by Council Member Carter to go into closed session. Council Member Hampton seconded the motion.

Council Member Nooe noted that his son was in the house and may pass through as the closed session was being held. He questioned if other people being around would be an issue while Council was in closed session.
